Thank you for participating in the *Descendants of Mexican War Veterans' Graves Registration Project*. The purpose of this project is threefold:

- To encourage remembrance of Mexican War veterans on Memorial Day and Veterans Day.
- To encourage the erecting of headstones on unmarked veteran graves.
- To provide present and future generations with useful genealogical research records.

When completing this form, please type or print using a black or blue pen. Take your time and provide as much information as you can. **If it is possible, please send a photograph of the grave site with the completed form.**

You do not have to be a descendant of the veteran in order to register his grave site. If you know the location of the grave of *any* Mexican War veteran, whether you are a descendant or not, please complete a registration form and send it to the DMWV National Office. If you *are* a descendant, please indicate in the space provided. If you are not related, please indicate by typing or printing the words "No Relation" in the space provided..

You also do not have to be related to a veteran to order a free V.A. headstone for an unmarked veteran grave. Please ask us to send information or visit our web page that provides instructions for ordering a grave marker from the Veterans Administration (<http://member.aol.com/dmwv/grvmrkr.htm>).
